Beginner clarinets typically use ABS plastic to balance ease of playing, sound quality, and durability. By contrast, Step-Up clarinets are made of carefully selected Grenadilla wood to focus in on an improved, warm sound.

Features such as tapered and undercut toneholes will more naturally play in tune, allowing the player to focus more on the music.

Improved Projection

The Grenadilla bells of Step-Up clarinets resonate much more freely, improving the tone and projection of low notes on the instrument.
